On 11/02/18 at approximately 1529 hours, Officers contacted John McCray, age 72, in a bar on Sea Level Drive due to a report of a threat. Mr. McCray was arrested for Violation of Condition of Release. Mr. McCray was transported to the jail where he was booked and held on no bail.

On 11/02/2018 at approximately 2009 hours, Officers responded to the 3400 block of Tongass Avenue for a report of male violating a protective order. Officers contacted Steven Scott, age 52, and based upon the investigation he was arrested for violating a protective order. Mr. Scott was transported to the state jail and set to be released on his own recognizance.

On 11/02/2018 at approximately 2144 hours, Officers responded to the 400 block of Dock Street for a report of a group of males in a fight. Officers contacted Jose Alvarado, age 43, who was arrested for disorderly conduct, transported to the state jail and set to be released on his own recognizance.

Mr. Milner showed signs of impairment; failed field sobriety tests, and was arrested for Driving Under the Influence. After submitting to a chemical test of breath, he was transported to state jail where he was booked and was to be released to his own recognizance.

On 11/03/18 at approximately 1613 hours, Officers contacted Robert Sero, age 37, in the 2400 block of Tongass Avenue. Mr. Sero was served a summons charging him with Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree. The summons stems from an October 2018 case.

On 11/04/18 at approximately 1100 hours, Officers responded to the 700 block of Deermount to a report of Maria L. McDaniel, age 44, violating a stalking order by being on private property she had been court ordered not to be on. Ms. McDaniel was arrested for Violating a Protective Order and Violation of Conditions of release. She was transported to the state jail and held on \$250.00 bail.

On 11/04/18 at approximately 1847 hours, Officers responded to the 100 block of Whitecliff Avenue and contacted Heather DeGuzman, age 31, due to a report of a domestic disturbance. Ms. Deguzman was arrested for Assault in the 4th Degree – Domestic Violence and Disorderly Conduct. She was transported to the state jail and held on no bail.
